Dear LID Customer,

This letter is to let you know that some exciting changes are happening in your area. Pulte Group, a builder here in River Islands has contracted to build homes in the area along River Bend Dr.. These homes will be constructed beginning in the next weeks. In order to provide adequate power supply to serve these homes, the current infrastructure will need to be fortified to serve the needs of this area, as the plans are for homes with larger energy loads than originally planned.

In order for this improvement to the infrastructure to occur, the existing cabling and supporting equipment will need to be removed and replaced. This will require the power to these areas to be de-energized for the safety of the crews working on the equipment. Some customers in the area will be affected while the energy supply is switched from our regular system to generator power. During the switch, customer will have a brief outage while transferring to the generator and then again when transferring back to the system. The anticipated dates for this to occur are 8/16 & 8/17 to switch to the generators and then on the same day when being transferred off the generator.

Some customers will experience a single, longer outage (expected to be approximately 1- 1 ½ hours) while smaller changes are being made. These customers will be affected on 8/15 – 8/18 beginning at approximately 7:30 am/pm and will not be transferred the generators.

Each homeowner will be notified in person when they will lose power from the field crew.

Please note that crews will work as quickly as they safely can to make these improvements and will strive to impact customers as little as possible, but there are always challenges when working around electric equipment. We ask that you not approach crews working as distractions can result in injuries to crew members and members of the public. If you have questions, please contact our office at 209-888-4799. In the event of any complications, our staff will update the website with information as soon as it becomes available. Otherwise, we hope this notice provides sufficient information to help you plan for the temporary outage.
