IMPORTANT NOTICE

On January 23, 2022 at 12:00AM Lathrop Irrigation District will be de-energizing the entire project in order to perform maintenance on the system. The outage is anticipated to last for 4 hours until 4:00AM Sunday morning. The maintenance that is required is past due and we need to complete this to ensure safe operation of our electrical system.

LID is currently operating on 1 distribution transformer. We are however in the middle of a capital improvement of 4 million dollars to install a second transformer in our substation. The completion of that is scheduled for the end of 2022. Once we have that operational, we will be able to transfer the load between the 2 transformers and eliminate the need for outages for routine maintenance.

Please notify your alarm companies of the up coming outage. Also, please be sure to charge your phones, have flashlights available, & turn off any sensitive equipment that is not on a battery back-up that can last 4 plus hours.
